

ABOUT THE PREGISP PROGRAM



GISCI is expanding into the emerging professional space by offering a pathway that helps recent graduates develop the qualifications needed for GISP certification as they begin their careers in the geospatial field.



What is the PreGISP Program?

- Offers an accelerated pathway to becoming a GISP
- Offered as a certification that is exam-only based
- Based on a standardized pre-professional exam based on UCGIS Geospatial Body of Knowledge
- Offered at the end of a student's career in their final GIS&T class
- Allows student to add credential to CV



What is the GISP-E Credential?

- Students who successfully pass the exam will be awarded the Emerging GISP credential and may use the GISP-E postnominal after their name.
- The credential will be valid for 3 years from date of award and cannot be renewed
- The exam to become a GISP-E is offered as an online proctored exam during a limited window in April & November of each year



Who is a GISP-E candidate?

- Undergraduate and graduate GIS students (2 or 4 year universities) preparing for the job market
 - Must be within your final semester of education, or within six months of graduation to take the exam
- Career changers entering the geospatial field
- Early career professionals planning long-term growth



Benefits of GISP-E Credential

- <u>Demonstrating knowledge</u>: the GISP-E credential shows commitment to your career and validates your skills and knowledge.
- <u>Enhancing credibility</u>: Credentials can boost your confidence and earn you respect from your peers and clients.
- <u>Career advancement</u>: Credentials can help you meet workplace requirements, get a promotion, or change careers.
- Valuing education and training: Credentialing programs can validate the education and training that students receive and can motivate them to continue to achieve.

The PreGISP Certification isn't just a practice test—it's a **career development milestone**. For students and new professionals, it bridges the gap between academic learning and professional certification.

It helps you **think like a GISP**® before you officially become one.

About the Exam

- Derived from the combined the knowledge bases of the UCGIS GIS&T Body of Knowledge and the European EO4GEO Body of Knowledge
 - 521 knowledge, skills, and abilities (KSAs) identified.
- The **exam** is designed to assess the knowledge you've gained during your education, covering 13 of these knowledge areas
- The exam is proctored online, and costs \$125 per attempt.
