GISCI Board of Directors:
A Board comprised of individuals, appointed by the Members, that is the governing body of GISCI

GISCI Oversight Committee:
Informs the Board of Directors on needed revisions and updates to the program. Discusses structural changes to the program to make sure it stays current, relevant, clear, and effective. Members maintain and ensure the quality of all program materials. Changes to the point structure will stem from Committee discussion with outcomes being sent to the Board of Directors for review and action.

GISCI Ethics Committee:
Develop programs that emphasize the GISCI Code of Ethics and the ethical behavior of certified GIS professionals. Maintain the Code of Ethics and suggest changes or additions. Examine ethics abuses and take necessary steps to resolve them.

GISCI Review Committee:
Resolves disputes and inconsistencies with the submitted applications and determines the status of all applications.

GISCI Outreach Committee:
Formulate, recommend, and with the Board's approval, undertake activities intended to increase the exposure and effectiveness of GISCI and its certification program and to enhance the Institute's support of its GIS professionals
