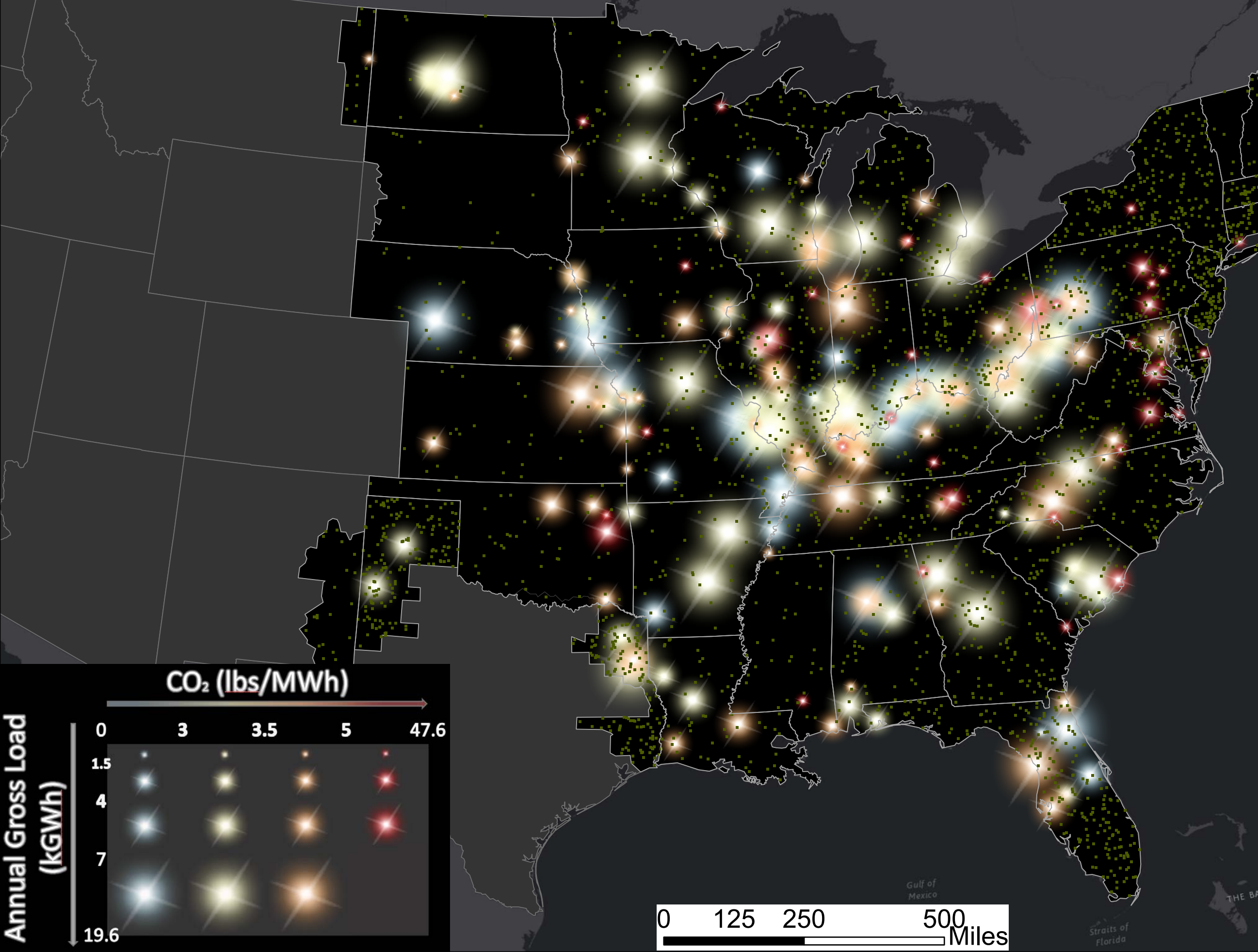


Eastern U.S. Coal Power Plants CO2 Emission Rate (2018)



Total Population (ESRI 2018)
1 Dot = 100,000

Each flashing point represents a coal-fired power plant. The color shows the CO2 emission rate level, while the size indicates the annual electric production level.

The greenish-grey dots show the population in each state.

Coal power plants with high CO2 emission rates usually supply less electricity.

There is no strong correlation between high CO2 emission rates and states with a large population.
