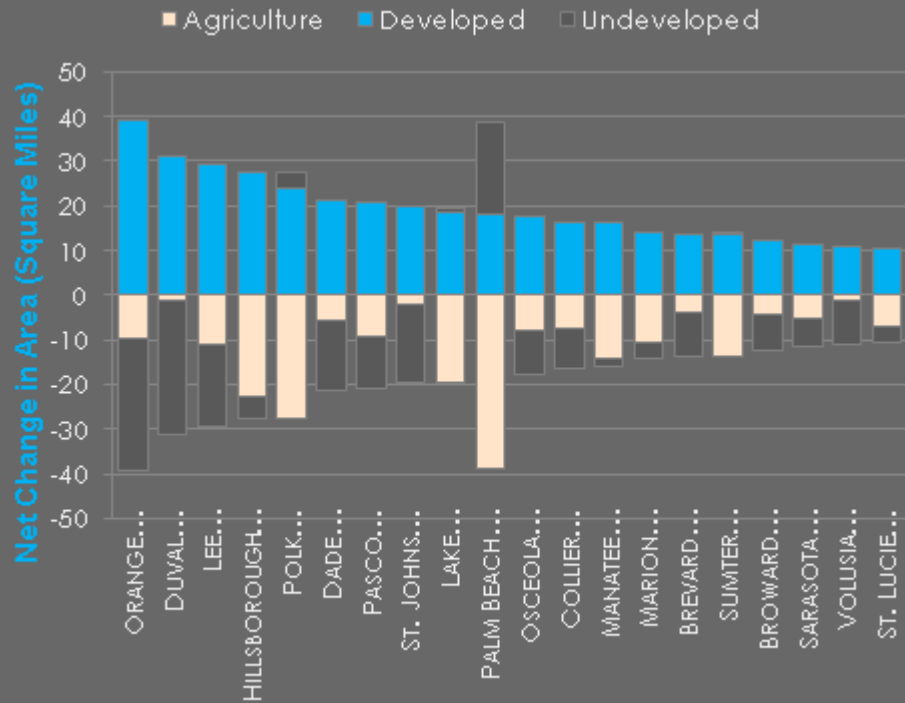


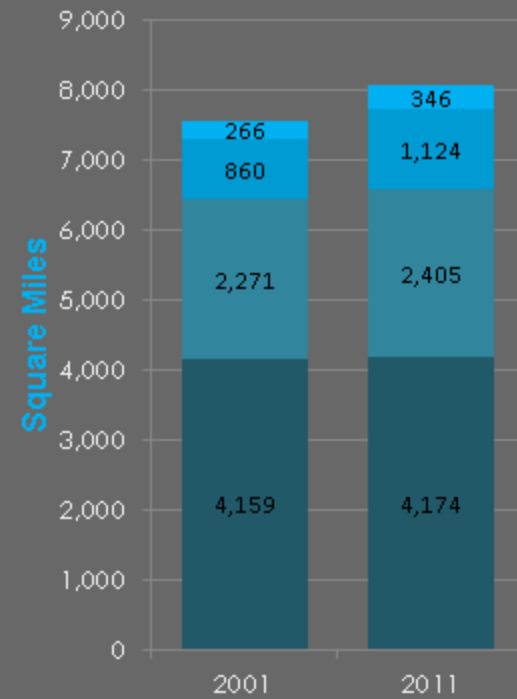

Top 20 Florida Counties

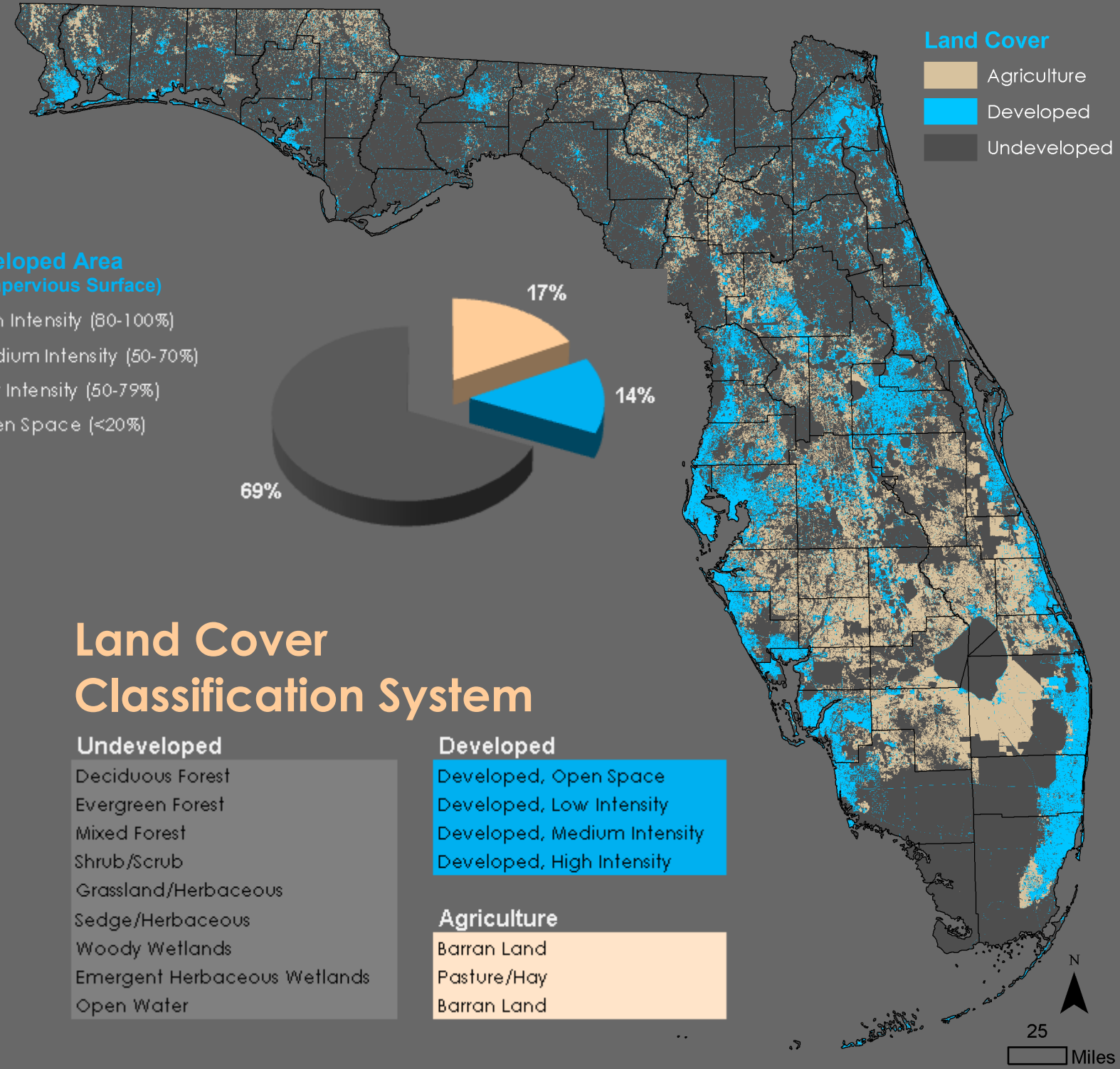
Area of Developed Land Cover



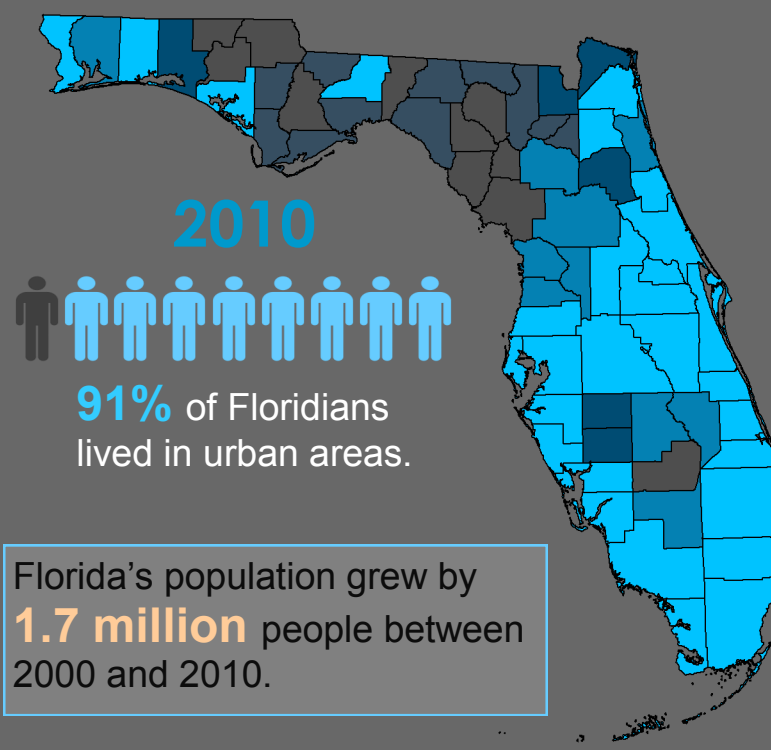
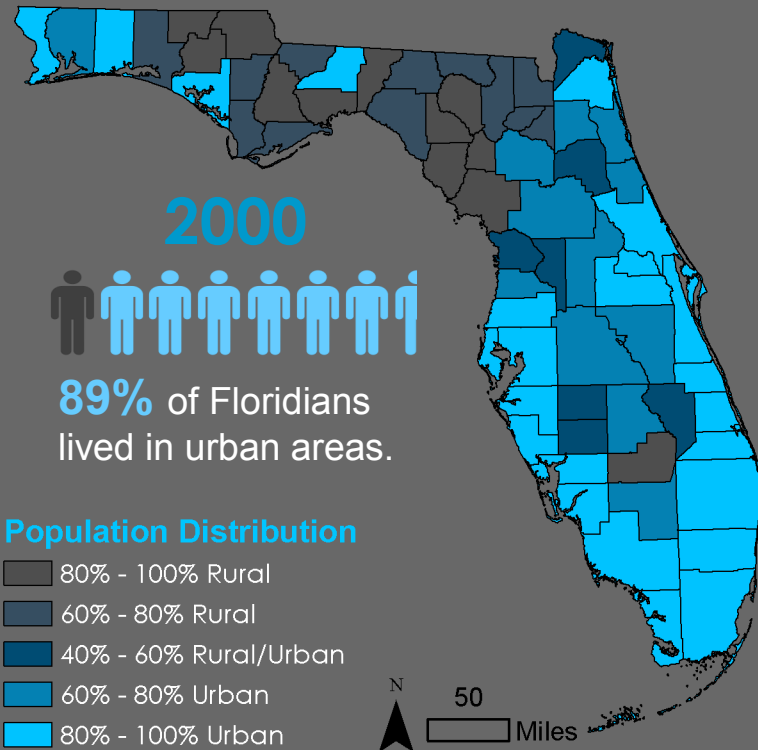
Developed Area (% Impervious Surface)
