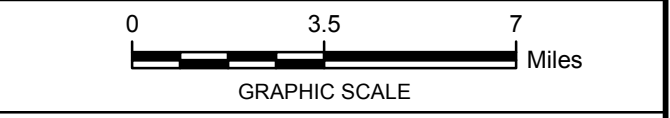

LOCATIONS OF THE ADIRONDACK'S 46 HIGHEST PEAKS AND LAND USE/DEVELOPMENT PLAN

"THE ADIRONDACK HIGH PEAKS" IS COLLECTIVELY 46 MOUNTAIN PEAKS IN THE ADIRONDACK MOUNTAINS TALLER THAN 4,000 FEET. HOWEVER, AFTER SURVEYING, FOUR PEAKS UNDER 4,000 FEET AND ANOTHER ABOVE 4,000 FEET HADN'T BEEN INCLUDED. THE ORIGINAL 46 ON THE LIST REMAINED THOUGH AND NO PEAKS WERE REMOVED OR ADDED. A PERSON WHO CLIMBS ALL 46 PEAKS EARNS THE TITLE "46er"
